TASTING NOTES

This Oregon Pinot noir is a beautiful ruby red in the glass, hinting at its vibrant character. On the nose, it opens with youthful aromas of bright redcurrant, raspberry, and cherry, all bursting with freshness. The palate reveals supple tannins and a balanced acidity, making it smooth and approachable. Flavors of red plum and black pepper intertwine with subtle notes of toast and fresh herbs, like rosemary, adding complexity. It's a wine that's delightful now but also has the potential to develop further with some cellaring.
