



GOTAS de MAR - ALBARIÑO



- The name “Gotas de Mar” means DROPS OF THE SEA. It’s a reference to the proximity of the vineyard to the ocean. You can even get a slight salinity in the wine which is mouth watering and delicious.
- These vineyards are in the far west of Spain, right above Portugal. It’s a cold growing climate, perfect for crisp, bright white wines like Albariño.
- The acidity, dryness, and citrus flavors make this an especially perfect match for selfish and seafood.
- Think of Albariño like a cross between a very DRY Riesling and Pinot Grigio, but with even more character.



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
