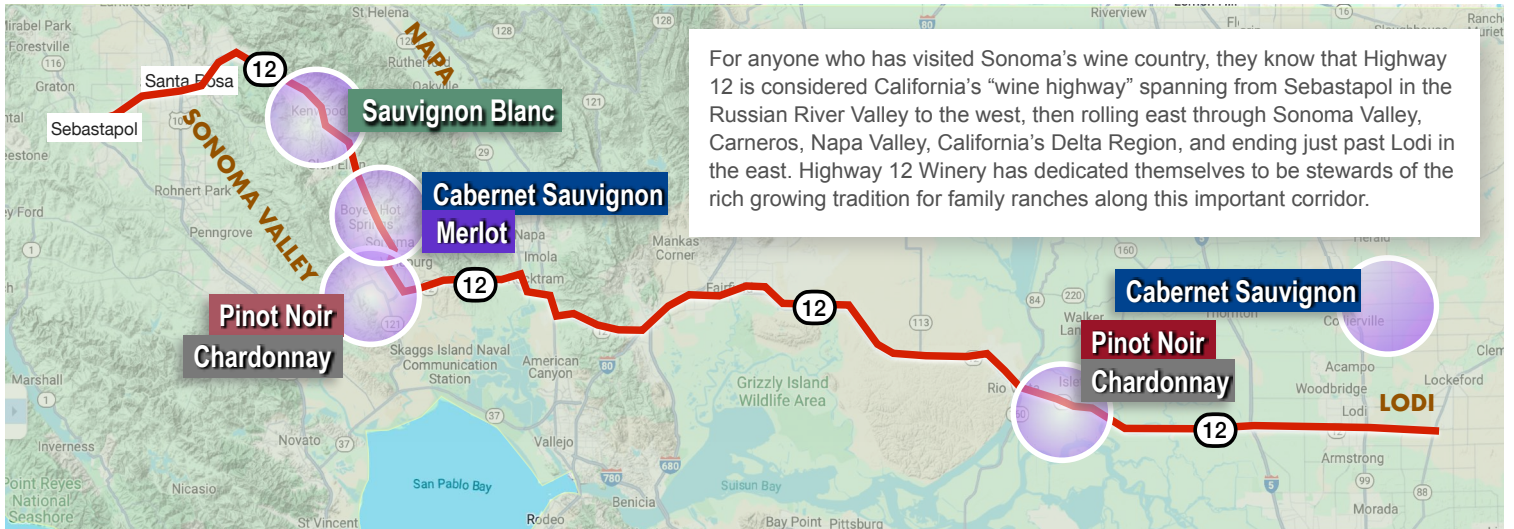

For anyone who has visited Sonoma's wine country, they know that Highway 12 is considered California's "wine highway" spanning from Sebastapol in the Russian River Valley to the west, then rolling east through Sonoma Valley, Carneros, Napa Valley, California's Delta Region, and ending just past Lodi in the east. Highway 12 Winery has dedicated themselves to be stewards of the rich growing tradition for family ranches along this important corridor.
