As one of the steepest, rockies, and windiest sites in the Willia Valley, just a hundred yards can have a massive impact on sun and wind exposure, soil type and d Multiple volcanic soil series are striated throughout the property and quite the range of aspects, fre East to true West. Even though the vineyard is small, the block-to-block variation can be as great as regions.

Bryn Mawr's location differs greatly from other sites in the Willamette Valley. Directly to its West Van Duzer corridor, a mountain pass in the Coast Range that acts as a massive wind tunnel for the the state to receive cool ocean winds on hot summer days.

Temperatures are regularly 5-7 degrees lower and winds much stronger than areas just 500 feet bel a result, vines are a bit more stressed and slower growing than those of their neighbors. During co vintages, grapes often need an extra few weeks to achieve full ripeness; but during warm vintages, maintain acidity and verve with above-average hang time.
